

# Camping Checklist & Info

## “North 40” Camping & the Show:

- Camping is \$30 per day, min of 3 days
- Requires EAA membership for one year = \$40 (can get it there, one person in your party must be a member).
- Registration and payment for camping is done on site, after arrival
- Buy tickets for the show when you register for camping, or get online beforehand
- Buses to the show regularly circulate along the road next to the campsites (can get quite full at the end of the day)
- Buses to places outside the show (seaplane base, EAA museum, etc.) leave from the bus park inside the show grounds
- Trams circulate inside the show on several routes. No bikes or scooters allowed
- The EAA Airventure Oshkosh App has other helpful info about speakers, exhibits, events, shuttles, georeferenced map, etc.

## Securing Aircraft:

- The Claw (plane tie down) or 3 24” ½ in. metal rods and hammer. You can buy tie downs after arrival if necessary
- 3 tie down ropes
- Platform for under wheels (to prevent sinking into the sod). We recommend using plastic cutting boards (see picture) – available at most supermarkets. Plywood also works

## Camping Basics:

- Tent
- Sleeping Pad or Blow Up Mattress
- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Camp Chair (important!)
- Flashlight and/or Headlamp
- Toiletries
- Towel
- Bug Spray & Sunscreen
- Hat & Sunglasses
- Camera
- Chargers / battery packs
- Rain Jacket
- Backpack
- Flip-flops/Shower Shoes
- OSH NOTAM (you will need it for departure)



## Camping Optional:

- Earplugs
- Baby wipes
- Camping table
- Camp Stove and Cooking Gear
- Cooler (for Snacks/Beverages/Ice)
- Snacks & Coffee
- Water Bottle(s)
- Clip for Hanging Wet Towel on Prop
- Binoculars
- Portable Radio (to listen to arrivals & airshow internal TAC)
- Solar Lights (for around campsite)

## Provided:

- Showers (warm water)
- Wifi (can be very slow)
- Electrical outlets at showers
- Electrical generator at C2A tent
- Water and Beverages at C2A tent
- Bagged Ice Available for Purchase
- Potable Water
